Whereas, Maureen A. Stapleton has announced her retirement from the San Diego County Water Authority after 40 years of public service and more than two decades as the agency's general manager; and

Whereas, she led a successful, multi-decade strategy to diversify and improve the reliability of San Diego County's water supply, which now supports a \$220 billion economy and the quality of life of 3.3 million people; and

Whereas, she transformed the Water Authority into a pioneering, visionary, agile, and driven public agency; and

Whereas, the Water Authority received numerous accolades during her tenure, including the top international engineering award from the American Society of Civil Engineers, and the Award for Excellence in water resources management from the Association of California Water Agencies; and

Whereas, she successfully negotiated the largest ag-to-urban water conservation-and-transfer agreement in U.S. history on behalf of San Diego County water ratepayers; and

Whereas, the she led the development of the \$1.5 billion Emergency & Carryover Storage Project to protect the region from water shortages; and

Whereas, she led the greatest period of investment in large-scale regional water infrastructure in San Diego County history, including the first new dam and reservoir in 50 years and the nation's largest seawater desalination plant; and

Whereas, she has been a pillar of San Diego civic life for decades through service on several boards and foundations.

Now therefore, be it resolved that Maureen Stapleton be honored on behalf of the United States House of Representatives and the constituents of the 52th Congressional District of the State of California on this day, the 28th of February 2019, for her lifelong contributions, exemplary leadership, and service to the San Diego region.
