VISTA IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO HOST TWO COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSIONS Sessions will share information about the District's water rate study and proposed rate increase.

The Vista Irrigation District (district) will be hosting community information sessions at its headquarters building located at 1391 Engineer Street in Vista on Saturday September 13, 2025 from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and Thursday September 18, 2025 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to share information about its water rate study and the proposed water rate and charge increases necessary to fund the cost of operations and critical systems improvements.

The same information will be presented at each session which are intended provide attendees with an opportunity to learn more about the water rate study process, proposed water rates and charges and upcoming critical capital improvement projects. Attendees will hear a brief presentation about the water rate study process and have questions answered by district staff. Tables will also be set up to provide information on water rate study, capital improvement projects, water quality and more.
